



*Luke 21:25-36*

Jesus said, "There will be signs in the sun, the moon, and the stars, and on the earth distress among nations confused by the roaring of the sea and the waves. For it will come upon all who live on the face of the whole earth. ## THE ADVENT WREATH - The First Candle: The Candle of Hope

Today is the First Sunday of Advent, the Sunday in which we recall the hope we have in Christ. The prophets of Israel spoke of the coming of Christ, of a Savior to be born, a King in the line of David. They spoke of how he would rule the world wisely and bless all nations. At Christmas, the hope of the world was born, Jesus Christ, the Son of God. On Good Friday He died. On Easter day He rose from the dead. He then ascended into heaven. On the last day, Jesus Christ, our hope, will come again to fulfill his Kingdom on the Earth and to bring to completion his mission among us.

We light this candle in HOPE to remember that, just as he came to us at Christmas, he will come again in power to deliver his faithful people. The light of this candle also reminds us to be alert and to watch in anticipation for his glorious return.




